
TUDORS HAPPY FAMILIES

Card game

INSTRUCTIONS

- You will need to print off the cards and cut them up.
- ❖There are 25 cards, shuffle the pack
- ❖Play in a group of 4
- Each player gets 5 cards
- The remaining 5 cards are face down in the middle
- The aim is to get a get a set of 5 cards about 1 Tudor monarch. You need to get their name, dates of the reign, religion, who they married, and important events
- Player 1 picks up a card from the face down pack. They then can either keep that card or discard it. If they keep it they must discard one held in their hand. You should only ever have 5 cards in your hand.
- *When it is discarded it must be face up, next to the face down pack
- Player 2 then has to pick up the face up card and then can either keep it and discard another card, or just discard the card just picked up to the face down pile.
- ❖ Player 3 and 4 do the same and keep going around until, someone gets the set.
- *When the face up pile has run out turn the face down pile upwards
- The person who gets the set of 5 cards wins
- Complete the chart at the end of the game.
