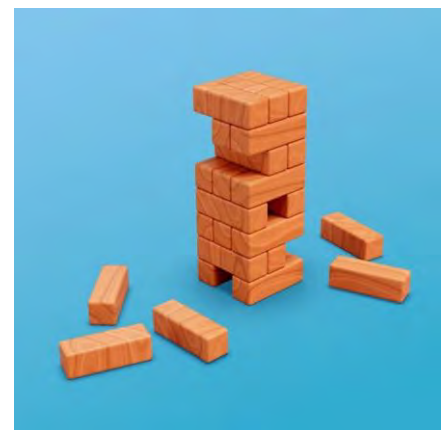


Train the Trainer: Foundation Year

A foundation year is a preliminary year that a student undertakes before they enter their full degree programme.

A foundation year is more than just a stepping-stone to a degree. Your students could benefit from the following:

- Full integration into academic and student life
- Development of core skills
- Access to a range of facilities, resources and specialist teaching
- Access to student loans for tuition and living costs
- Guaranteed place on the degree course if they pass the year.



Typically, a foundation year has lower entry requirements and may not have subject-specific requirements. For example:

[BSc Bioveterinary Sciences](#)

Entry requirements: **BBB** with Biology

[BSc Bioveterinary Sciences with Foundation](#)

Entry Requirements: **BBB** without Biology or **CCD** with Biology and a 2nd science

Note: a foundation year is not the same as a foundation degree. A foundation year gives students access to complete a full honours degree, whereas a foundation degree is a standalone qualification.

Spotlight on Reading: BSc Bioveterinary Sciences with Foundation Year

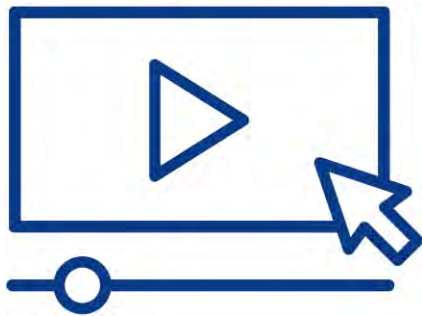


Our BSc Bioveterinary Sciences degrees focus on domestic and captive animals, their biology, health, and the science behind how humans manage them.
