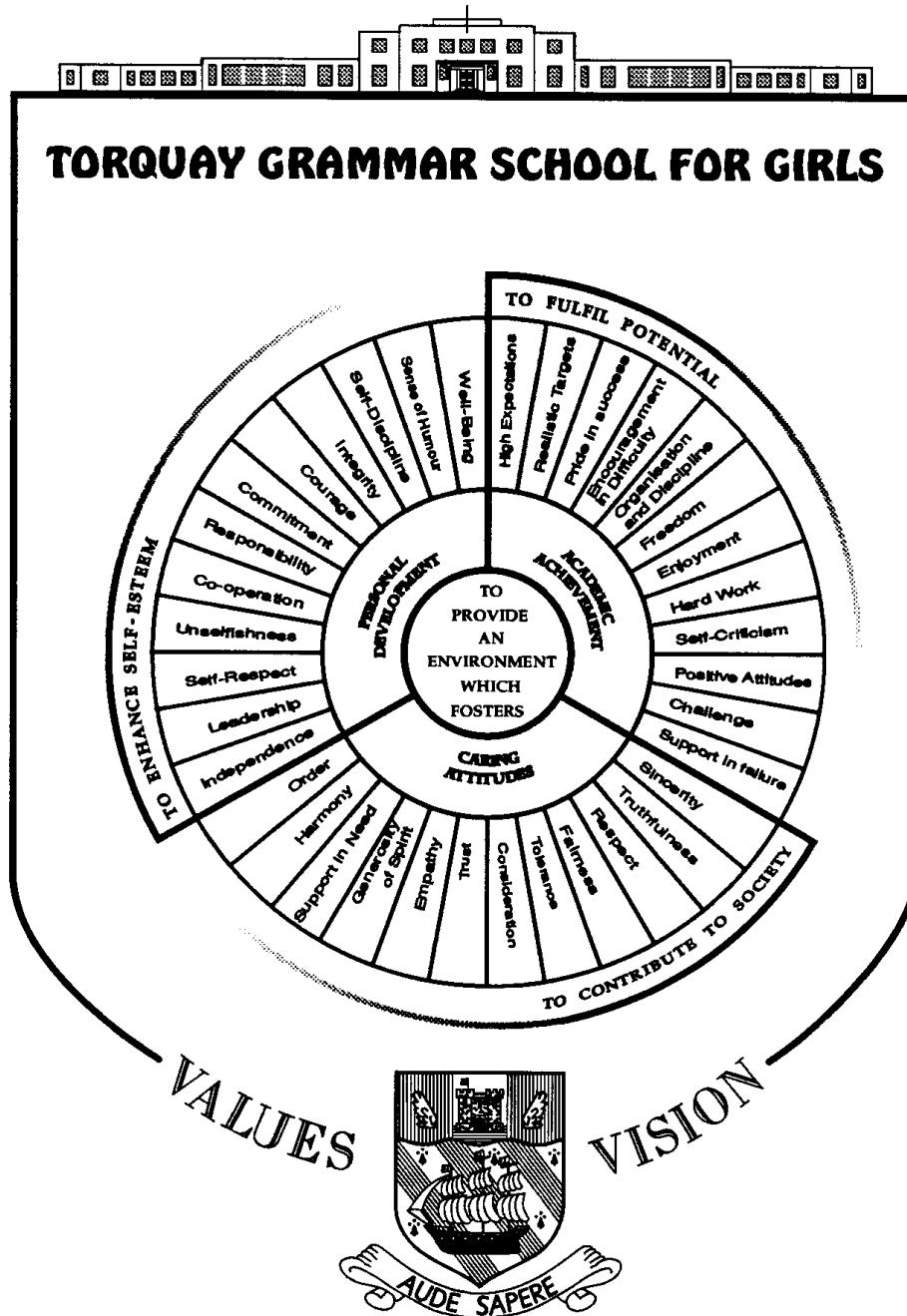


# TORQUAY GIRLS' GRAMMAR SCHOOL

## HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT



At Torquay Girls' Grammar School we believe that the responsibility for each girl's academic and personal progress is shared between the school and the parents of each girl.

The aims of the school and how we intend to achieve them are set out in the school compass above. The school community operates on a basis of mutual respect between all members:- girls, teaching staff, parents, support staff, governors and the local community. The current Code of Behaviour (overleaf) describes the behaviour expected of everyone. Details of all school procedures are given to all parents.

**Attendance:**

- Girls are expected to be on time every day.
- Parents are asked to phone on the first day of absence and to send a note confirming the absence on the first day of return.
- The school will attempt to notify the parents if a girl leaves the school premises during the day without permission.
- Parents are expected to avoid taking holidays in term time.

**Discipline:**

All girls are expected to behave well in school and on their journey between school and home. If disciplinary action is needed we expect parents to support the school in the maintenance of high standards of behaviour and discipline. In the event of a serious problem we will always consult with the parents of the girls concerned.

**Homework:**

The school will set homework because it is important to:

- Consolidate the work done in school.
- Provide wider opportunities for individual work.
- Develop a respect for learning.
- Enable teaching staff to monitor progress.

Parents are expected to support the school in the management of homework.

**Communication:**

The school will communicate with the parents on a regular basis through progress sheets, reports, parents' evenings and the school newsletter as well as sending letters about any activity or events which may affect their daughter. The school welcomes enquiries and visits at any mutually convenient time should a parent have any concern. Parents are asked to keep the school informed of any circumstances which may affect a girl's ability to work in school or require special consideration.
