

# **Post-16 Studies Learning Agreement**

When you become a post-16 learner at Torquay Girls' Grammar School you enter into an agreement with the school. This agreement outlines the commitments we expect and what we will offer in return. Please read the learning agreement carefully and sign to confirm that you understand and agree to these expectations. This agreement will cover the duration of your time in the Sixth Form.

#### As a student at Torquay Girls' Grammar School I will:

- Abide by the policies and procedures on attendance, registration, dress-code, smoking, drugs and conduct.
- Maintain at least a 90% attendance record.
- Be punctual for all school commitments. This includes registration in Year 12 and Year 13.
- Be honest, polite and co-operative with all staff and fellow students.
- Complete homework and coursework to an acceptable standard by the required deadlines.

### In return you can expect Torquay Girls' Grammar to:

Deliver your Learning Programme:

- A levels usually 10 lessons per fortnight per subject.
- Tutorial Sessions 2 tutorial sessions per fortnight to include: study skills, PSHE and future pathways.
- Extended Project to take place in Year 12.
- Enrichment Activities 2 hours enrichment per week.
- Study Sessions You need to use 80% of free periods for study, in the library or work room.

### Help you by:

- Offering advice and guidance in choosing your course.
- Providing appropriate pastoral and academic care whilst you are in the Sixth Form.
- Guiding you in your selection of progression routes on leaving school.

## Provide and education which:

- Challenges you to realise your potential.
- Encourages the development of positive relationships.
- Provides you with the skills needed to encounter a changing world.
